We'll visit the Anping Old Street, which is the oldest street in Anping District. While visiting the Anping Old Street, you will find lots of colorful sword lions that are hung on these historical residences. A sword lion is hung on each residence as an identification of the resident, as there was no address back in old days. The sword lions are designed in different sizes with diverse facial expressions and colors, in which the color of the sword lion represents the family's position in society.
