

TEA: FROM PLANTATION TO TABLE

Shortcourse 6-12 August 2017

Course Description

Tea is one of the most popular beverages worldwide. Indonesia is one of the largest producers and exporters of tea. This course will allow participants to study how tea is produced in Indonesia. Participants will learn hands-on tea cultivation, crop protection, soil nutrient management, tea harvesting and processing in Tambi Tea Plantation. The course is based on short introductory sessions in class followed by practical exercises in the field.
